David Fix Jr. is a Hudson Valley based painter whose work expresses the quiet encounters between figures, animals, and spaces. The recent paintings sometimes draw from old family photographs, rural imagery, and the emotions of remembered spaces. Using low-relief elements and paint, he creates scenes that feel familiar and off-kilter. Figures often appear suspended in moments of contact - relationships feel intimate but difficult to pinpoint.

Fix, Jr. was born in 1999, in Hudson, New York, where he lives and works. This is his second exhibit with The Fireplace Project, and first solo exhibit.
